- Church must provide background checks on all adult sponsors.

New Registration Process

Reserve spots at supersummer.net beginning January 21

- Go to supersummer.net to reserve spots for your group. Select the week you would like to attend and follow the registration instructions.
- Indicate the number of campers {youth and adults} you anticipate bringing. Please give your best estimate (you will not be restricted to this number, but we do need an honest estimate). If your selected week does not have space available, you will be instructed to select a different week.
- Complete all of the contact information on the registration form. You will need to pay a deposit to reserve your spots.. Online payments can be made by credit/debit card or electronic check. **Your reservation will not be complete until payment is made.** You will receive immediate confirmation that your group is pre-registered.
- Pre-registration only reserves space for your group in your preferred week.
 Individual registrations must be completed by the deadline you receive in your confirmation email. After your deadline, any unused spaces will be forfeited.
 - Prior to March 6, go to supersummer.net and download the registration instruction page to give to every family. A sample of the registration instructions are on the following page. Locate your church ID number (from the list posted on the website) and fill that in on the registration instruction page before you make copies. Other event information will also be posted at supersummer.net.
 - •Parents can register their students online beginning March 6. Parents and sponsors will complete the online registration and submit payment online. If you have people you are scholarshipping, contact us for instructions.
