 Due to the nature of Super Summer, no infants or children may attend Super Summer.







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SPONSOR DETAILS \$ REQUIREMENTS

- Sponsors must be at least 21 years of age & must be capable to provide supervision & care for the needs of students
- Sponsors are to hold their own students accountable for rules
 - If you see other students who need redirection, please find their sponsor(s) and communicate observations.
- The suggested ratio is 1 sponsor for every 8 students. Make sure you have the appropriate number of sponsors for each gender.
- All sponsors must have a background check report completed within the last 3 years on file with the Church Forward office:

- Guests are required to obey all guidelines, including dress codes.
- Guests may not attend Church Group Meetings unless approved by the Camp Director.
- Guests are welcome to visit camp from 2:00-8:30pm
- Non-registered guests will not be allowed to spend the night.
- If guests eat at camp, they will be charged \$13/ meal.





SUPER SUMMER GUIDELINES

- There will be no possession or use of tobacco, e-cigarettes, alcohol, and/or drugs except for the purpose of medication. Immediate expulsion may result from violation of this guideline.
- Electronic entertainment devices (such as iPads, Video games, etc.) are not allowed.
- Only sponsors & staff may have cell phones.
 - If any items are discovered, leaders are required to confiscate & lock-up until the end of camp.















SUPER SUMMER GUIDELINES



Dress is not to distract from the purpose of Super Summer

- Campers must dress appropriately. Casual clothing is acceptable during all Super Summer activities.
- Shorts & a bright t-shirt must be worn to & from the swimming areas. Everyone must wear a bright t-shirt while swimming in the lake or pool. Shorts must be worn over swimsuit during BLAST Games.
- Hemlines & necklines must be modest. Backless dresses, & bare midriffs are not allowed.
 All shirts must be long enough, no skin is visible above the waistband.

- All shorts must be modest


 (approximately mid-thigh length or longer). Message shorts (those with writing across the seat of the shorts) are not permitted.
- All clothing must have sleeves.
- Shoes must be worn at all times, except while playing sand volleyball & swimming.
- Clothing advertising inappropriate music groups/individuals, sex, tobacco, alcohol, and/or drugs should not be worn.
- Sagging shorts/pants are not allowed.











K.P. -KITCHEN PATROL



- When you arrive at camp, you will receive your assignment.
- Every group is assigned to one meal.
- When you report for K.P. you will be given instructions & assignments (such as filling drinks, picking up trays, sweeping, scraping trays, etc.).
- Some groups choose a theme and dress up while this is not a requirement, it may be something you encounter and want to consider bringing supplies for your group. Supplies/costumes cannot distract or inhibit individuals from serving
 - Examples include: Super Heroes, Under the Sea, Christmas, Cowboys.
 - Please remember: if sharing KP duty with another group, you can offer & share items, but they cannot be forced to participate.

BLAST GAMES



- Water games are a significant part of the BLAST Games. Please bring appropriate clothing (Swimsuits, bright t-shirts, shorts and shoes that can be wet will be needed).
 - When you arrive at Super Summer, you will be assigned to one of four BLAST teams.
 - If a church group is large enough it would constitute 50% or more of a team, your group will be divided among 2 or more of the BLAST teams.
 - It's fun. It's low-skill recreation. It's wild. It's a BLAST!

RECREATION/CHALLENGE COURSE INFO

- All recreation activities are free of charge for those attending Super Summer. For most activities, equipment is provided.
- Challenge Course:
 - Challenge Course is "challenge by choice"- if an individual goes to challenge course and decide not to participate, their wish will be respected & they will not be forced to participate.
 - Students cannot participate without a release form completed during the registration process and electronically signed by their parent/guardian. This cannot be changed once students arrive at camp.
 - Challenge Course is a system of elements designed to provide a church group with team building initiatives.
